

ABC safe party

Safe parties and events for women in Medellín

How to prevent violence against women at parties and events?

Target audience: production staff, logistics teams, and party/event attendees.

What to do in a violent situation?



If a woman's life or her safety is somehow threatened, or at risk or there's any emergency, **call the safe line 123 and ask to activate the SAFE PARTY ALERT.** Share your contact number and the exact address. The Agencia Mujer Medellín will call you back to guide and assist you.



Without compromising your safety and putting yourself at risk, **keep the woman company until she feels safe.** You can escort her to the nearest Alcaldía de Medellín Safe Spot at the event and report the situation to them, this might be a Red Cross brigade group or an ambulance.



If you're escorting her to take a car to get home or to a safe location, **help her by writing down the car's information such as the car's plate, and ask if she'd like to share her number** so you can make sure she arrives safely.



If you're one of the staff members at the event, and the woman agrees, **ask her permission to share her name and contact number** with the Secretaría de las Mujeres de Medellín. That way, they can follow up and offer further support to her.

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No olvides:



Self-care: avoid exposing yourself to unnecessary risks, such as getting involved in confrontations or fights.



Solidarity: support anyone in danger by acknowledging their situation and emotions without judgment.



Discretion: do not share photos, videos, or sensitive information about the woman or the situation without her consent.



Due Institutional diligence: actions must be taken quickly and effectively to ensure the safety of the woman at risk.
