

ABC: ask for Angela

How to activate the “Ask for Angela” protocol?

Target audience: working staff at nightclubs, bars, and commercial establishments.



If a woman asks for Angela and she's alone:

Offer to call 123 and activate the SAFE PARTY ALERT.

Give the staff your contact number and the address you're currently at. The Agencia Mujer Medellín will call you back to guide and assist.



If a woman is with someone, appears

uncomfortable, and asks for Angela: **Check whether she feels safe giving you more information in front of the person she's with.**

If it's not the case, proceed to activate the SAFE PARTY ALERT protocol, give your contact number and the address you're currently at. The Agencia Mujer Medellín will call you back to guide and assist.



Check whether she feels safe giving you more information in front of the person she's with. Also,

discreetly identify who the woman is, who she is with, and what her condition seems to be based on your observation.



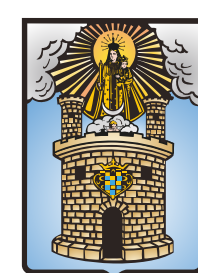
If the woman is conscious, offer her to call 123 and activate the **SAFE PARTY ALERT.**

If she is unconscious or unable to respond, call 123 immediately and request urgent support, providing your contact details and the exact location you're at.

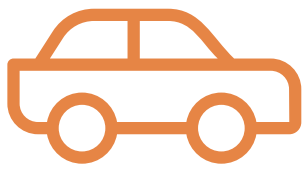

If you work at a nightclub or bar and the woman agrees, **ask her permission to share her name and contact number** with the Secretaría de las Mujeres de Medellín (Women's Secretariat of Medellin). That way, they can follow up and offer further support to her.



If you're escorting her to take a car to get home or to a safe location, **help her by writing down the car's information such as the car's plate**, and ask if she'd like to share her number so you can make sure she arrives safely.

Important to remember:



Without putting yourself at risk, stay with the woman until she is safe, or report the situation to other staff at the venue.

Don't forget:



Self-care: avoid exposing yourself to unnecessary risks, such as getting involved in confrontations or fights.



Solidarity: support anyone in danger by acknowledging their situation and emotions without judgment.



Discretion: do not share photos, videos, or sensitive information about the woman or the situation without her consent.

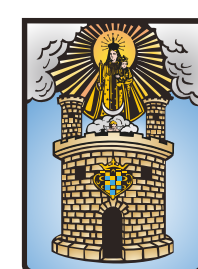


Due Institutional diligence: actions must be taken quickly and effectively to ensure the safety of the woman at risk.
